Creating a competition
 How will the competition work? Will the dance routines be scored on technical ability or on aesthetic appeal? For example; does the dance routine look good and is it in time with the music?

How complex are the moves? For example; should performing a handstand score more points than an arm wave. You will need to decide the scoring. Below is a table to give you some ideas.
